- Aadhar Card
- PAN Card
- Bank Account
- Registered office proof

Although it is not mandatory for getting the sole proprietorship to be registered with any of the Government authority but it is advised to get some registrations like SME, GST Registration and can also register itself under Shop and Establishment Act. These registrations help the person for future growth

PARTNERSHIP FIRM

In Partnership business, the members are individually partners and share the liabilities as well as profits of the firm in a predetermined ratio. It is such a business structure in which two or more individuals manage and operate a business in accordance with the terms and objectives set out in a Partnership Deed that may or may not be registered.

We need the following for Registration of the Partnership Firm:

- 1. Form No. 1 (Application for registration under Partnership Act)
- 2. Original copy of Partnership Deed, signed by all partners
- 3. Affidavit declaring intention to become partner
- 4. Rental or lease agreement of the property/campus on which the business is set
